Subject: Prior Authorization Requirement for Non- Emergent NICU Transfers and Transports

Summary

Please be reminded that CareSource continues to require prior authorization for non-emergent neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) transfers and transports.

Impact

The last three years have presented health care systems with unique and unprecedented challenges. Hospitals and providers were stretched to the limits in terms of bedspace and staffing. Despite this, CareSource remained committed to providing the best access to care for our members. The ability to move patients between hospitals and hospital systems became necessary and it was our priority to make this process smooth and timely.

As per CareSource policy, all non-emergent neonatal transfers and transports will require a prior authorization based on the line of business.

Importance

Failure to obtain prior authorization before non-emergent transfer of a neonate will result in the denial of the hospitalization as well as denial of the associated transportation.
