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**Summary**

Beginning Jan. 1, 2024, CareSource will provide reimbursement for a model of integrated behavioral health care known as the **Collaborative Care Model (CoCM)**. The Collaborative Care Model (CoCM) is a specific type of integrated care developed by the University of Washington to treat common health conditions in medical settings like primary care. Behavioral health conditions such as depression, anxiety, post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), alcohol, or substances use disorders are among the most common and disabling health conditions worldwide. Based on *principles of effective chronic illness care*, CoCM focuses on defined patient populations who are tracked in a registry to monitor treatment progression.
