We require that additional authorization be obtained every 30 days for continuation of the wound vac based on the criteria that is outlined in the medical policy. CareSource will approve a wound vac with a stage III or IV pressure ulcer, chronic neuropathic ulcer and additional ulcer types that are outlined in the policy. CareSource will also approve for wound complications and surgical complications as well with additional criteria needing to be met that is outlined in the medical policy.
