A. Subject

Preventive Evaluation and Management Services and Acute Care Visit on Same Date of Service

B. Background

Reimbursement policies are designed to assist providers when submitting claims to CareSource. They are routinely updated to promote accurate coding and policy clarification. These proprietary policies are not a guarantee of payment. Reimbursement for claims may be subject to limitations and/or qualifications. Reimbursement will be established based upon a review of the actual services provided to a member and will be determined when the claim is received for processing. Health care providers and office staff are encouraged to use self-service channels to verify member eligibility.

It is the responsibility of the submitting provider to submit the most accurate and appropriate CPT/HCPCS code(s) for the product or service that is being provided. The inclusion of a code does not imply any right to reimbursement or guarantee claims payment.

CareSource will reimburse participating providers for medically necessary and preventive screening tests as required by federal statute through criteria based on recommendations from the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF).

C. Definitions

- x **Preventive Services** ±Exams and screenings that check for health problems with the intention to prevent any problem discovered from worsening and may include, but are not limited to, physical checkups, hearing, vision, and dental checks, nutritional screenings, mental health screenings, developmental screenings, and vaccinations/immunizations. Regularly scheduled visits to a primary care provider for preventive services are encouraged at every age but are especially important for children under the age of 18 years.

D. Policy

- I. When any of the following pediatric and adolescent preventive exam codes are billed on the same date of service as an acute care visit with the appropriate ICD-10 codes, CareSource will reimburse both codes at 100%.
 - A. Preventive Health Service Codes
 - 1. 99381-99384
 - 2. 99391-99394
 - B. Acute Care Visit Codes
 - 1. 99202-99205
 - 2. 99212-99215
- II. When any of the following adult preventive health service codes are billed on the same date of service as an acute care visit with the appropriate ICD-10 codes,
